PLEASE LABEL THESE ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME:

- One (1) box of Crayola brand 24 count crayons. No Rose Art crayons, please
- One (1) pair of good quality, sharp-nosed Fiskar scissors
- One (1) set of water base markers, slender size, 8 to 12 count
- One (1) set of water base markers, wide size, 8 to 12 count
- One (1) set of colored pencils
- Four (4) red pencils
- One backpack for carrying materials to and from school
- One (1) wide-rule Composition Book, hard cover 9¾ x 7½ inches
- Two (2) wide-rule spiral notebooks
- Two (2) plain colored folders with pockets at the bottom
- One (1) plastic folder with pockets at the bottom
- One (1) Hand Sanitizer, 8 oz to 12 oz
- One set of headphones or earbuds

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE COMBINED FOR STORAGE AND SHARED USE. PLEASE DO NOT LABEL THESE WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME:

- 24 Ticonderoga sharpened pencils. #2 wood only, please, no plastic
- Twelve (12) Black Expo Dry Erase markers
- Twelve (12) glue sticks. No Elmer's white glue, and no Rose Art glue sticks, please
- Four (4) large Pink Pearl erasers
- Four (4) containers of unscented handiwipes or baby wipes, 150 count
- One (1) large boxes of tissues

IMPORTANT REMINDER!
