PLEASE LABEL THESE ITEMS WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME:

- ___ One (1) box of Crayola brand 24 count crayons.
- ___ One (1) pair of good quality, sharp-nosed Fiskar scissors.
- ___ Three to four (3-4) Expo brand black dry erase markers.
- ___ Four (4) colored highlighters.
- ___ One (1) sock to use as eraser for the white boards.
- ___ One (1) pencil sharpener WITH COVER to catch shavings.
- ___ One (1) set of water base markers, slender size, 8 to 12 count pack.
- ___ One (1) plastic school supply box, 6" x 8".
- ___ One (1) set of colored pencils.
- ___ Six (6) red pencils.
- ___ One backpack for carrying materials to and from school.
- ___ Two (2) wide-rule Composition Notebooks, hard cover 9¼ x 7½ inches.
- ___ Three (3) wide-rule spiral notebooks.
- ___ Four (4) plain colored folders with pockets at the bottom.
- ___ One (1) set of earbuds for Chromebook use.

- ___ One (1) large box of tissues.

IMPORTANT REMINDER!
